Course Information:

This course is designed for the first responder and is an operator level course. When students graduate they will take the knowledge they have gained and apply it to an active shooter incident. This course will cover the critical tasks that need to be considered when preparing for and responding to an active shooter incident. Students will be actively engaged in scenario-based training. Students will learn what procedures and tactics that are involved in an active shooter response incident, citizen/student rescue tactics, and hostage rescue. They will learn basic methods for communicating and working with other agencies when on scene. They will learn different interdiction methods and when to recognize the transition from an active shooter to a barricaded gunman. Students will also review laws involving use of force and active shooter history. There is a non-reimbursable fee of \$231.00.
