We are pleased to announce the creation of a NEW way of training. **S.T.O.P.** (Sheriff's Tactical Operations Program) is designed to be completed over a 4/10 (40 hour) training week and specifically geared toward completing ALL mandated Perishable Skills, Continued Professional Training, and State Mandated training. Defensive Tactics / Racial Profiling / Range

 Students will be actively involved utilizing a broad base of instruction from instructors from throughout the region.

DAY TWO
Pursuit liability / EVOC
